BOOK DRIVE FOR BOARD BOOKS WITH A SPECIAL THANK YOU FROM DISNEY ON ICE

However, it is also true that those early literacy board books get heavily used and are in need of replacement at a faster rate than most books for older ages. Stockton-San Joaquin County Public Library is asking the community to bolster their board book collection so they can continue to provide the best free early literacy opportunities for children.

By partnering with Feld Entertainment, the Library is able to thank board book donors by providing vouchers for free tickets to the Disney On Ice show that will be at the Stockton Arena beginning Thursday, February 5 through Sunday, February 8. Make an ordinary day extraordinary when Disney On Ice presents Let's Celebrate! This show on ice brings more than 50 Disney characters to the Stockton Arena for one colossal party!
